ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

Generally, a child is first eligible to enroll in MMS programming beginning at 18 months of age, at which time they will be considered for admission to our Toddler Classroom Community. All children approved to apply for enrollment in our Toddler classroom will first need to schedule a developmental readiness assessment with MMS' Toddler Lead Guide and/or an MMS Director.

MMS will not explicitly rule out the enrollment of a child between 14 and 18 months of age. A guardian seeking to apply to MMS for enrollment of a child between 14 and 18 months of age will arrange a meeting with the Toddler Lead Guide and/or an MMS Director, who will assess the child's relevant abilities before their anticipated start date. In general, the child must:

- Be able to independently and reliably walk for a length of time outlined by the staff member(s) leading the child's assessment. If the child is differently abled and meets the classroom's age requirement, the child will be assessed accordingly.
- Be able to independently and reliably hold an approved object for a length of time outlined by the staff member(s) leading the child's assessment. If the child is differently abled and meets the classroom's age requirement, the child will be assessed accordingly.

Our guiding philosophy relies on a number of factors, and while enrollment is generally predicted on a "first come, first served" basis, approval for student enrollment is ultimately at the discretion of MMS.
